







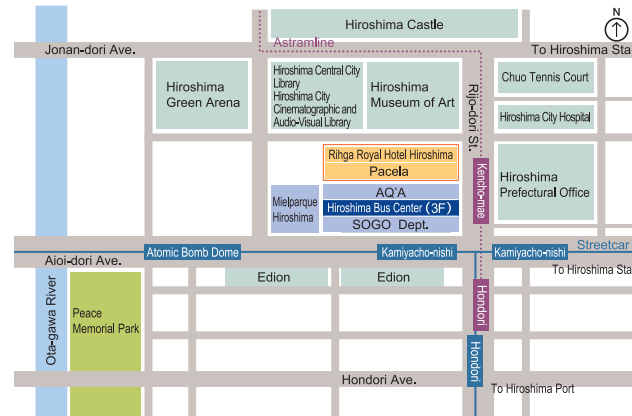




How to ride the bus

There are two types of buses arriving at and departing from the Hiroshima Bus Center--"board from front door, exit from front door type" and "board from door in center of bus, exit from front door type". The way you board will differ depending on the bus, so please check what kind of doors the bus has before boarding.


Board from front, exit from front type



Please buy your ticket from the ticket sales point inside the Hiroshima Bus Center in advance. (You may not be able to board a highway bus if the seats are sold out)



Highway buses are board from front, exit from front types. (Some busses will require you to take a numbered ticket when boarding. When boarding these, please take the numbered ticket)




When you hear the announcement for your stop, please press a stop request button near you (when there is no stop request button, please get off the bus at your stop). When getting off, please insert your ticket or cash (Japanese yen).


Notice

-If you have the "VISIT HIROSHIMA TOURIST PASS", please show the bus crew your pass when you get off. Also, please note that if you ride outside the bus zone you will be required to pay an extra fare.
-Please note that on buses with stop request buttons, if you do not press the button at your bus stop the bus will pass by it.
-When paying fares inside a bus, please use Japanese yen. Please note that you cannot pay with foreign currency or credit cards.


Board from center door, exit from front type




Please buy your ticket from the ticket sales point inside the Hiroshima Bus Center in advance.



Standard busses (in some cases boarded from the front) are boarded from the center and exited from the front. (When boarding, please take a numbered ticket located inside the door)



When exiting, pay in cash (Japanese yen only). When you pay, pay the amount indicated by the number on the numbered ticket you took when boarding (in the case of the above illustration, a ticket with number 2 on it means 210 yen)




When you hear the announcement for your stop, please press a stop request button near you. When getting off, use the front door. As you get off, please insert your numbered ticket and ticket or cash (Japanese yen)

HISTORICAL ARCHITECTURES

From Hiroshima Bus Center

1 Kintai kyo Bridge

Board at Platform 1 Bound for Iwakuni and Higashi Seto in Yamaguchi pref.

This arch bridge is made of wood entirely over the Nishiki gawa (river) in Iwakuni city Yamaguchi prefecture. Famous for cherry blossoms in early spring.
56 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Kintai kyo bus stop.
One-way ticket 930 yen

2 Ikouji Temple

Board at Platform 9 Bound for Masuda in Shimane pref.

This temple is in Masuda city in Shimane prefecture. The Main gate was removed from Masuda castle and reconstructed at the present place, which has an impressive appearance.
146~190 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Ikouji bus stop.
One-way ticket 3,700 yen

3 Iwami Ginzan; the Silver Mine of the World Heritage

Board at Platform 9 Bound for Ohda in Shimane pref.

Iwami Ginzan was designated as the world heritage in 2007. You can walk through a precious and valuable archaeological silver mine.
145 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to world heritage center.
One-way ticket 3,090 yen

4 Izumo Taisha Shrine

Board at Platform 9 Bound for Izumo.

Izumo Taisha shrine is in Izumo city in Shimane prefecture. The God is famous for marriage maker.
187 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Izumo Taisha shrine. Transfer at Izumo station or Izumo city station. One-way ticket 4,300 yen (Izumo Taisha Shrine)

5 Okunoshima

Board at Platform 5 Transfer at Tadanoumi bound for Okunoshima.

A poison gas factory used to be located on this small island with a circumference of about 4km. It is now inhabited by about 700 wild rabbits.
102minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Okunoshima(Transfer at Tadanoumi bound for Okunoshima Is.). One-way ticket 1,490 yen(Tadanoumi Station)

6 Senkouji koen Park

Board at Platform 6 Bound for Onomichi, Imoshima.

You can look down the whole city of Onomichi from the observation deck. The park is famous for cherry blossoms in early spring.
98 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Senkouji shimo.
One-way ticket 1,750 yen

7 Tomonoura Sea Port

Board at Platform 6 Transfer at Fukuyama bound for Tomonoura.

Tomonoura flourished as a port waiting for tide and wind for shipping since long time ago and there still remain many historical sites and town streets.
135 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Tomonoura.
(Transfer at Fukuyama bound for Tomonoura) One-way ticket 2,900 yen



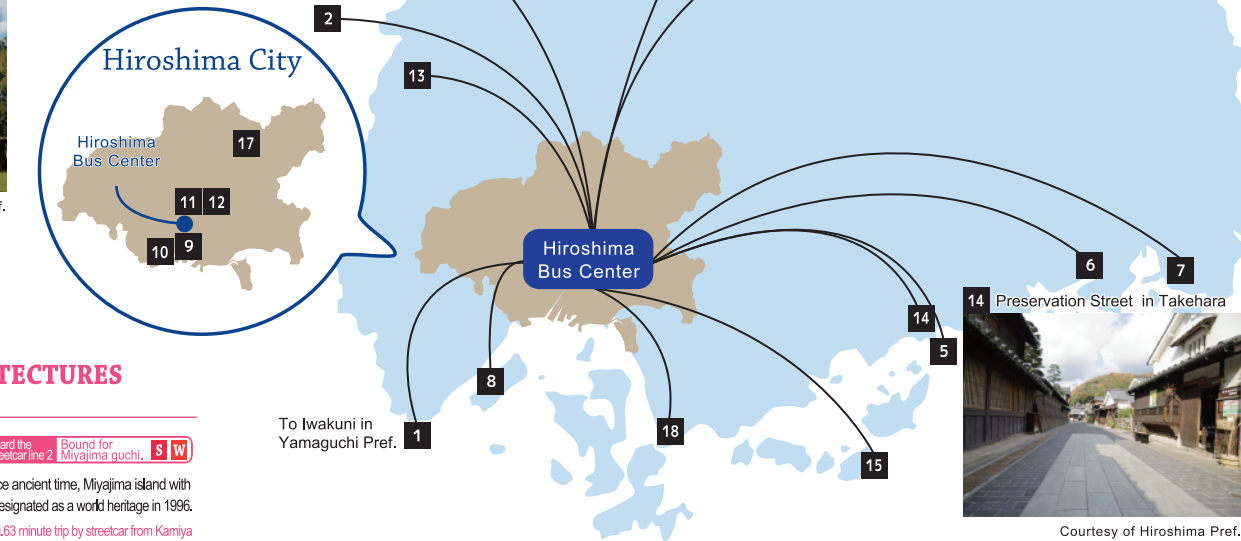

HISTORICAL ARCHITECTURES

On foot or by streetcars

8 MIYAJIMA

Board the streetcar line 2 Bound for Miyajima guchi. S W

Otherwise regarded as an "Island of God" since ancient time, Miyajima island with "Itsukushima shrine" standing on the sea, was designated as a world heritage in 1996.
Board the streetcar line 2; bound for Miyajima guchi.63 minute trip by streetcar from Kamiya chou nishi stop to Miyajima guchi. Take a ferry boat to Miyajima. One-way ticket 440 yen

9 A-bomb Dome

On foot

10 Peace Memorial Park

On foot

The ruined dome is a witness of the disaster of A-bomb devastation, designated as a world heritage in 1996.
7 minutes on foot from Hiroshima Bus Center.

11 Hiroshima Castle

On foot

Famous "Carp Castle" This castle tower now stands in the form of a historical museum.
10minutes on foot from Hiroshima Bus Center.

12 Shukkeien Garden

On foot

Famous for a beauty spot of flowers, the garden presents the seasonal sceneries of four seasons and is designated as an outstanding beautiful spot by the government.
20 minutes on foot from Hiroshima Bus Center.

BEAUTIFUL SPOTS AND PRESERVATION DISTRICT

13 Sandan Kyo

Board at Platform 7 Bound for Sandan Kyo. W

The valley with various waterfalls and pools shows impressive beauty in flesh sprouts in early spring and with colourful leaves in autumn.
75 minute trip by express bus from Hiroshima Bus Center to Sandan Kyo.
One-way ticket 1,440 yen

14 Machinami Hozon Chiku; Preservation Street in Takehara

Board at Platform 5 Bound for Takehara Tadanoumi. W

Along with historical and contemporary architectures, the town street district was designated by the government, where you can feel daily life of old times.
80 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Michi no Eki Takehara (Vehicle Station). One-way ticket 1,340 yen

15 Mitarai Machinami Hozon Chiku; Preservation Street in Mitarai

Board at Platform 6 Bound for Onomichi-tenmangu. S W

The town street district lies along with historical and contemporary architectures of 18th-20th century, where you can feel daily life of old times.
140 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Mitarai Port.
One-way ticket 2,000 yen

PARKS AND MUSEAMS

16 Bihoku Kyuryo Koen Park (Northern Hiroshima Pref.)

Board at Platform 9 Bound for Shobara, Tojo. W

A large botanical park for family, including experiences and camping.
Nearest Bus Stop; Bihoku kyuryo koen (or transfer at Shobara Bus Center).
Board at Platform 9 for destination; Shoubara or Tojou.
137minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to the Park. One-way ticket 1,900 yen

17 Garasu no Sato (Glass craft museum and workshop)

Board at Platform 9 Bound for Obayashi Syako or one bound for Kami Ogasashi and/or Yoshida. W

Attracted by the famous bead works overseas as well as in Japan.
51 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Shimo Obayashi bus stop.
One-way ticket 490 yen

18 Yamato Museum

Board at Platform 6 Bound for Kure, Awa and Hiro. S W

Battle Ship sunk in East-China Sea at the end of the World War 2; 1/10 size of the original ship is displayed. Salvaged items, soldier's will notes and man-toxepodes are displayed.
44 minute trip from Hiroshima Bus Center to Kure Station bus stop.
One-way ticket 720 yen
