# Hiroshima Area Route Map

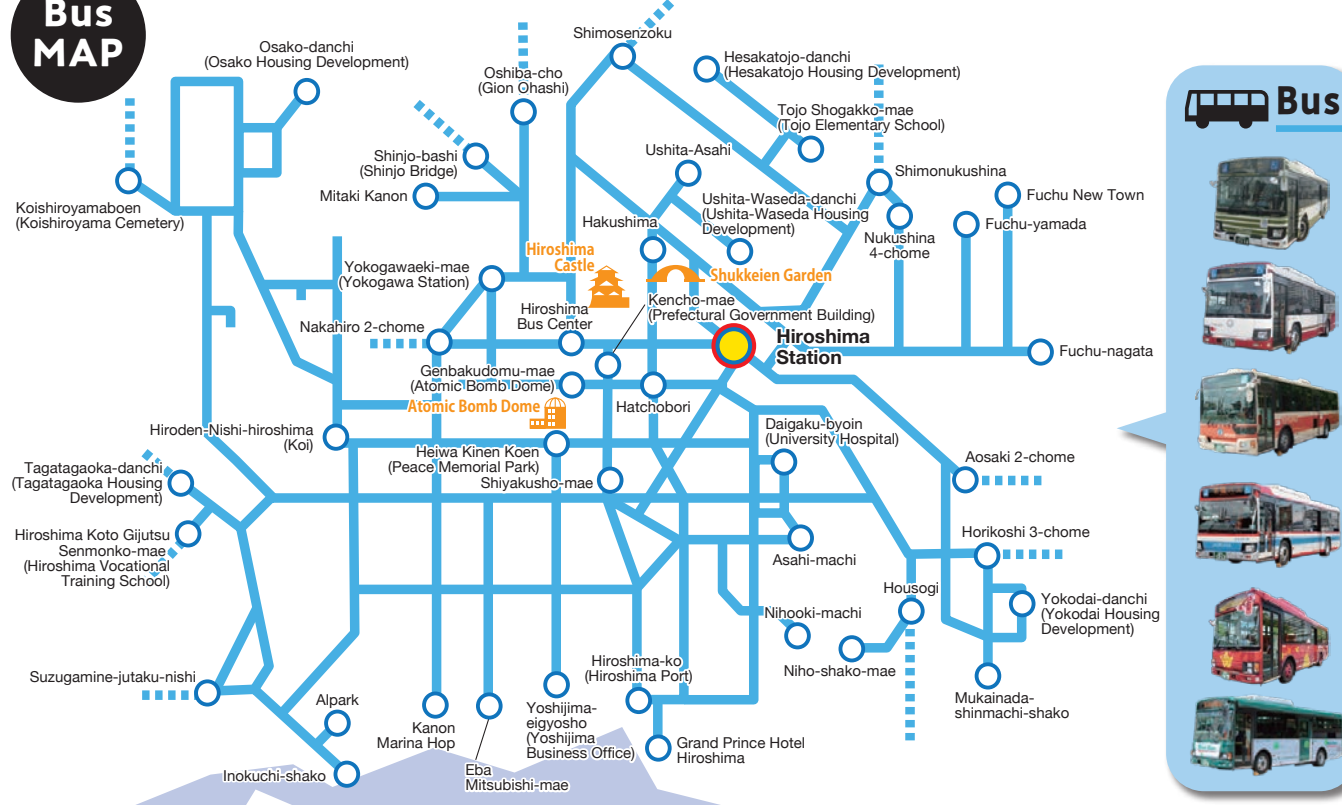
You can use the tourist pass within the area shown below.

## Digital Ticket

### Purchase

Purchase a digital ticket on the "MOBIRY" website.

Payment is completed on this website. Purchased tickets can be activated at any time within a 90-day period, including the date of purchase.

### Use

When you select "start using", the digital ticket will be displayed on your device. To use your digital ticket, display it on your device, and then show it to the driver, a crew member, or other personnel.

- \* Present your digital ticket when getting off a streetcar or bus, and before getting on a ferry.
- \* Go to the information counters indicated below to receive your book of coupons. You must present your passport at this time.

### Refund

You can receive a refund for an unused ticket on the "MOBIRY" digital ticket website, within the activation period of the unused ticket. You will be charged a separate refund fee.

## For Digital Tickets Only

If you purchase a digital ticket, you can also purchase optional tickets for the airport limousine bus (to Hiroshima, to Kure) and express buses (Hiroshima - Sandankyo Gorge, Hiroshima - Miyoshi/Shobara, Hiroshima - Iwakuni, etc.) on the website.

- \* The selection of optional routes will be expanded gradually.
- \* Optional tickets can be used only within the period of validity for your Visit Hiroshima Tourist Pass.



## Paper Tickets

### Purchase

You can purchase a ticket at the locations indicated to the right.

When you specify an activation date, that date will be stamped on your ticket.

- ★ You can purchase a ticket up to 1 week before the activation date.
- ★ You must present your passport when purchasing a ticket.

### Use

Show your stamped ticket to the driver, a crew member, or other personnel.

- ★ Present your stamped ticket when getting off a streetcar or bus, and before getting on a ferry.

### Refund

You can receive a refund for an unused ticket at the counter where you purchased the ticket, no later than the day before the activation date for the unused ticket. You will be charged a separate refund fee.

**You will receive a coupon book together with your ticket.**
