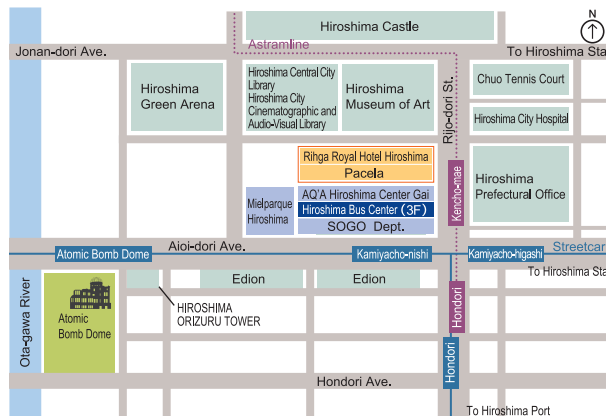

# KURE

The government office of the Kure City which is approximately 45 minutes away from the Hiroshima Bus Center by bus, was opened by the Kure Navy District in 1889, and as a shipbuilding and weapons munition manufacturing site in addition to being a navy base, received fame as “the greatest navy port of the East”. Even now, Kure is still a flourishing construction business for large-scale civilian vessels when tracing from the establishment of Yamato, the Battleship which made this city become the most famous navy arsenal in Japan. As there is also the Kure base for the Japan Maritime Self-Defense Forces (JMSDF), many large-scale vessels and warships landing and leaving Kure Port and it is bursting with the history and vitality of the Marine power, and is a port where you can enjoy the panoramic view of mountains, sea, and island in a comfortable climate when facing the Seto Inland Sea.

This faithfully reproduces the details, using the design drawings and photographs of the time, as well as video from an underwater survey. This is a symbol of the Yamato Museum.

## YAMATO MUSEUM

The Kure City Maritime History and Science Museum, which will have its 15th anniversary in April 2020, is widely known by its nickname "Yamato Museum". You will find a large number of precious real exhibits, such as the Carrier-based "Zero" Model 62 and Special purpose submarine "Kairyu". This is a Science Museum in which you will be introduced in detail to the history of pre-war and post-war Kure City and various "science and technology", such as various types of shipbuilding and steelmaking using materials, video, and models from the time, which continues to communicate the wonders of science and technology and importance of peace to future generations.

## TETSU-NO-KUJIRA-KAN (IRON WHALE MUSEUM)



**Submarine "Akishio"**

"Yushio"-type submarine actually used by the JMSDF. Part of the inside of the submarine in which the actual item is displayed has been opened for general viewing, and you can take a tour showing the structure of the submarine and way of life onboard the submarine.

Information



This is a memorial museum on top of a gentle slope on "Bijutsukan-dori", which is lined with trees and has 17 sculptures by famous artists scattered around. The former Kure Navy Office Commander Government Building connects both a Western-style building assumed to be for the reception of foreign visitors and a Japanese-style building used for everyday life. The Western-style building section has "Kinkarakami" wallpaper, the likes of which are found very rarely in Japan, and this opulent space played the role of a reception hall.

#### Kinkarakami

This was originally used for the walls and ceilings of European palaces, is brightly colored and embossed with leather, and was manufactured as an alternative to Japanese paper.

# KURE BAY WARSHIP TOUR

In the Kure Bay Warship Tour, you can go on a luxurious cruise, where you observe a wide range of JMSDF war vessels close up, such as Destroyers and submarines, while listening to an explanation by former JMSDF members.

#### Boarding procedures

Exchange your boarding ticket by 20 minutes before it departs at the reception on the first floor of Kure Central Pier. Please make a Web booking in advance from the website (up to 2 days before the cruise). A certain number of tickets are available on the day, but as these are limited, you should apply in advance.



#### Alley karasukojima

If you are fortunate, you may have the opportunity to see the battery on the submarine being charged!

#### Night Kure Cruise

This is a special cruise that departs 15 minutes before sunset, which enables you to see the scene of a Self-Defense force flag being lowered against the bright red sunset of Kure Bay. (Book 2 days in advance)

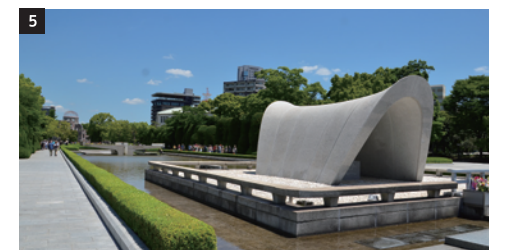

The 37th National Hananowa Urban Green Fair in Hiroshima named "Hiroshima Hananowa 2020" is held near the Atomic Bomb Dome. The venue is adorned with 180,000 flowers from over 300 varieties. It includes a section named "Hope and Memories Zone" that sends Hiroshima's message of peace and recovery to the world, as well as an area, which is the fair's symbol, called "Hiroshima Scenery Zone" where you can see a variety of scenery ranging from sea to mountains, through its display of flowers and greenery.

### HIROSHIMA ORIZURU TOWER

Hiroshima, this year, marks the 75th anniversary of the atomic explosion. The "Atomic Bomb Dome" is one symbol of that. You can see the Atomic Bomb Dome from the top of the "HIROSHIMA ORIZURU TOWER". The view seen from above tells you things about the dome that you do not notice from ground level. The amount of debris on the ground, the direction of the blast as seen from the blast area, the warped spiral staircase... These things all teach things to those of us surviving today.

Method of casually enjoying the Hiroshima specialty "Okonomiyaki"

### Okos! (Handheld Okonomiyaki)

The Akushu Café -Park Side- (HIROSHIMA ORIZURU TOWER 1F)



In Hiroshima, "Okonomiyaki" which is baked on a hot plate using plenty of cabbage, with a special sauce poured over it, is a famous dish. This is usually eaten on the hot plate, but on the first floor of "HIROSHIMA ORIZURU TOWER", at the cafe here, they have developed a form of "okonomiyaki" that you can take out.

Local people love the taste of the cabbage and its original texture. This is truly authentic Hiroshima Okonomiyaki and is a new classic menu item for Hiroshima.

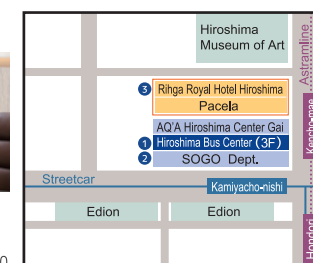

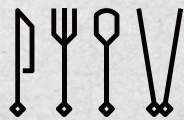

## How to ride the bus

There are two types of buses arriving at and departing from the Hiroshima Bus Center--"board from front door, exit from front door type" and "board from door in center of bus, exit from front door type". The way you board will differ depending on the bus, so please check what kind of doors the bus has before boarding.
